Posters:

All posters will be on display for the duration of the conference. We will also run the two poster sessions mentioned in the timetable. During these sessions, we invite authors to stay close to their posters to answer questions. Authors have the responsibility of preparing their posters. Posters should not be larger than DIN A1 (594x841mm). Some authors may prefer to have their posters printed in Faro, especially if they are travelling by plane. We contacted specialist printers to request a price for this service. The price is about 10 euros per poster. If you wish to have your poster printed in Faro, before the conference, please send a PDF of the correct size to the organisers by 15th January 2018 at the latest. This will allow us to have your poster mounted and displayed by Friday 19th January, 2018.

Lectures:

Please prepare a Microsoft Powerpoint file to support your lecture. **It is VERY VERY IMPORTANT that each speaker tests his/her presentation in order to check its running time.** The moderator will have strict instructions to stop the presentation if a speaker does not finish in time. In most cases, you will have 25 minutes available and in some cases you will have just 15 minutes available. We suggest that you reserve a few minutes of this to answer questions at the end. Powerpoint files, or a link for downloading them, should be sent to the organizers before 19th January 2018 at the latest.

Registration:

The registration fee will be **120 euros**. This includes all conference coffee breaks and lunches. This will also cover the cost of the Conference Dinner - an evening meal at the University. Registered participants will be informed during January 2018 how payment can be made.

Conference proceedings:

We will publish proceedings online after CONSOLFOOD2018. We encourage all participants to write a full length academic paper for inclusion in our conference proceedings, using the template available at <http://www.consolfood.org>.

Your completed paper should arrive, by email, before 20th December, 2017.

Equipment:

We have plenty of space for a large outdoor exhibition of different types of solar cookers, solar dryers and other related equipment. If weather permits, we will prepare "caroffee", "carotea", carob cake, and some lunch, using solar power.
